

JUEVES 14 DE MAYO

Buenos días: ¿qué tal estáis? Espero que todo vaya bien. Lo que os mando a continuación es lo de esta semana:

Classbook pages 56 / 57 (audio 64) y A.B page 55

Os voy a explicar el Simple Present. Puede que, al principio, sea un poco “lioso” pero con la práctica (estudiando, haciendo ejercicios, repasándolos...¡lo que ya sabéis que os he dicho millones de veces!) seguro que se “deslía”. Hay que leerlo todo una primera vez para “hacerse una idea” y luego otra y otra y otra...las que cada uno necesite.

Además...¡Ya lo hemos estado utilizando de forma intuitiva (enseguida os daréis cuenta)! y ahora lo vamos a estudiar en profundidad. **¡Es muy fácil!**

Este tiempo verbal se utiliza para expresar **acciones que ocurren habitualmente**: todos los días, todos los meses, todos los años, a menudo...no es algo que se esté haciendo “en este momento”, es algo que hago “casi siempre” o “siempre”.

Por ejemplo:

- .Yo me cepillo los dientes todas las mañanas.
- . Ella va al colegio en autobús.
- . Mis padres trabajan en Madrid.

También el simple present **suele ir acompañado** por los **Frequency Adverbs**, que se escriben delante del verbo. Los más usados son:

Usually : generalmente

Sometimes : algunas veces

Always : siempre

Often : a menudo

Never : nunca

Por ejemplo: She always studies English / You often read a book.

Para formar las oraciones seguimos el siguiente esquema.

Affirmative: subject + verb +

. ¡OJO! Si el subject es: **he, she, it** tenemos que añadir al verbo una “s” o “es” (si el verbo acaba en : o, s, sh... pero eso ya lo iremos viendo, ¡no os preocupéis!).

Ejemplos: He **gets up** at nine o'clock.

Katy **goes** to school on foot.

Negative: subject + **do not(don't) / does not (doesn't) + infinitive** (sin “s”) + ...

Doesn't con **he, she, it**

Don't para el resto **I, you, we, they.**

Ejemplos: **He doesn't** get up at nine o'clock.

Katy doesn't go to school on foot.

They don't feed the fish.

We don't go to bed at ten o'clock.

Interrogative: do / does + subject + infinitive

Ejemplos: **Does** he get up at nine o'clock?

Do they feed the fish?

¡OJO! En negativa e interrogativa ya **NO** ponemos la “s” porque vamos a usar el auxiliar “**does**”.

Resumen:

Affirmative: subject + verb ("s" con he, she, it) + ...

Negative: subject + don't / doesn't + infinitive + ...

Interrogative: Do / does + subject + infinitive +

Más ejemplos:

1. Tom works in Alcobendas / Tom doesn't work in Alcobendas / Does Tom work in Alcobendas?
2. My friends go to school by bus / My friends don't go to school by bus / Do my friends go to school by bus?
3. The cat eats the fish / The cat doesn't eat the fish / Does the cat eat the fish?
4. She does her homework / She doesn't do her homework / Does she do her homework?
5. We play the piano / We don't play the piano / Do we play the piano?
