

✓ What do you need to make a snow shelter?

How to survive in the Arctic Make a snow shelter

- You can't dig a snow shelter on flat snow, so first look for a slope.
- Check you have about 2 metres of snow for your shelter.
- With a shovel, dig an entrance tunnel, which should be about 1 metre long.
- Then start digging out the snow. The roof and the walls
 of the shelter should be at least 60 centimetres wide.
- If there are trees nearby, put branches on the floor so that you are not touching the snow.
- Put a rucksack in the entrance to keep out the wind.
- If possible, light a candle to give you light and warmth.




