WORKSHEET NUMBER 1

This activity is a <u>wordsearch</u> (sopa de letras). You are to find some irregular past participles. In the activity, the verbs are in infinitive so you need to check your irregular verbs list if necessary. The document also contains the answer key.

WORKSHEET NUMBER 2

"Have you ever...?" "¿... alguna vez ...?"

E.g. Have you ever _____ (be) to London?

Have you ever been to London?

¿Has estado alguna vez en Londres?

There are some "Have you ever" present perfect questions in this document. The only thing you've got to do in order to complete them is to write the past participle of the verbs in brackets. Most of them are irregular verbs... Watch out!! Check your irregular verbs list if necessary.

WORKSHEET NUMBER 3

This activity is very easy. You have to fill in the gaps with the present perfect form of the verbs in brackets. You may note that there are two spaces in each sentence. We need to write the auxiliary *have / has / haven't / hasn't* in the first gap and the past participle of the main verb in brackets in the second one.

E.g. My sister _____ (write) a letter today.

My sister has written a letter today.

WORKSHEET NUMBER 4

This worksheet is the same as worksheet number 3. But, apart from filling in the gaps with the present perfect forms, you have to circle the words *regular / irregular* depending on whether the verb is regular or not.
